

**Remedy Selection Semi-Annual Progress Report
Cross Generating Station, Class 2 Landfill
§257.97**

Overview

The South Carolina Public Service Authority (Santee Cooper) is implementing the April 17, 2015 U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) Federal Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) Rule (40 CFR § 257 and 261) for the Cross Generating Station, located in Berkeley County, South Carolina.

Requirement

§257.97(a) The owner or operator must prepare a semiannual report describing the progress in selecting and designing the remedy.

Summary of Actions Completed to Date

To date, the following activities have been completed in selecting and designing a remedy:

- A corrective measures assessment (CMA) report for the Cross Class 2 Landfill was completed June 12, 2019 and placed on the publicly available website.
- Santee Cooper requested approval to modify the seepage collection system of the Cross Class 2 Landfill. South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) approved this request October 2019.
 - This modification was completed to meet state requirements.
 - This modification of the seepage collection system was a component of the preferred remedy alternative presented at the public meeting.
- A public meeting was held on December 3, 2019 at Cross Generating Station to allow the public to comment on the remedial alternatives outlined in the CMA report.

Planned Activities

Upcoming tasks related to the Cross Class 2 Landfill will include the following:

- Respond to comments from the public meeting;
- Complete the Remedy Selection Report;
- Continue groundwater monitoring under assessment monitoring program until groundwater remedial activities are initiated; and
- Complete seepage collection system modification project with DHEC approval to meet state requirements as an interim measure.
