## Peak Hurricane Season is Here!

*Here are a few tips to keep in mind during and after a storm.*

- Stay away from downed power lines. Always assume the line is energized and never touch it or attempt to move it. Stay clear and call **888-769-7688** to report any issues.
- Never climb a utility pole or tower.
- Never try to repair or remove debris from lines.
- Never use generators indoors or in a garage even if doors and windows are open. Do not connect your generator directly to your home's wiring.
- Store fuel away from generator and add when generator has had time to cool from running.
- Stay tuned to your local weather channel and have our contact information handy if you need to report any electrical issues before, during and after the storm.
