Santee Cooper was part of teams that successfully attracted Redwood Materials to Camp Hall and DC BLOX to Myrtle Beach's ITAP commerce park and enabled Nucor Steel to expand in Berkeley County and Carolina Food Services to expand its Loris Commerce Park presence, among other developments. In 2022, Santee Cooper and the state's electric cooperatives helped bring more than \$4.9 billion in capital investment and 3,460 jobs to South Carolina.
