New rates took effect with bills issued starting April 1. These rates include updated time-of-use (TOU) energy charges and the introduction of a demand charge for GA customers. On-peak hours are 3 to 7 p.m. daily from April to October and 5 to 9 a.m. daily from November to March.

Why have rates changed?

We need to invest in our system to maintain high reliability and comply with regulations. Our rates have been flat since 2017.

How do the peak hours impact my demand?

Peak hours for GA customers impact energy charges, not demand. The on-peak energy rate is one cent more than the off-peak energy rate. Demand is separate and charged based on the highest half-hour of energy use of each billing cycle.
